

3 Card Poker Progressive

Rules

- ★ Three Card Poker Progressive™ is an exciting stud poker game that offers three ways to play and four different ways to win. You may bet against the dealer, bet on the value of your own three card hand, or bet both. Bonus payouts may be had for certain hands when wagering against the dealer.
- ★ **Pair Plus** - lets you bet against your own hand. If your hand contains a pair or better, you win.
- ★ **Ante** - lets you play against the dealer's hand. It's just your cards against the dealer's. If you make an ante bet and like your hand, you must place an equal wager on the PLAY spot.

The dealer needs a Queen or better to qualify. If the dealer does not qualify, your Ante bet automatically wins even money and your Play bet pushes.

If the dealer qualifies, he compares his hand to yours. If you win, your Ante and Play bets win even money.

Rules Cont.

- ★ **To Play Both** - It's you and your cards for a pair or better; it's you and the dealer for the best three card poker hand. You must also make the PLAY wager or you will forfeit the ANTE wager.
- ★ **Ante Bonus** - If you make the ANTE and PLAY wagers, you may win a bonus payout even if the dealer doesn't qualify and even if the dealers hand beats your hand.
- ★ **Progressive Payouts** - The optional \$1 progressive bet wins if you have Straight or better. See payable for odds. If you get Ace-King-Queen of spades, you win %100 of the progressive jackpot.
- ★ **Envy Bonuses** - The top two hands trigger Envy Bonuses. You win if any other player gets AKQ suited or AKQ of spades. (Player must have bet on progressive.) You can win multiple Envy Bonuses in a round, but you cannot receive Envy Bonuses for you own hand or the dealers hand.

Hand Rankings from Highest to Lowest

Straight Flush

Three of a Kind

Flush

Pair

- ★ If no hand contains a pair or better, the hand that contains the highest-ranking card(s) wins. Ace is high except in 3-2-Ace sequence.
