

Roulette

Rules

- ★ Roulette chips can be purchased and cashed only at the Roulette table.
- ★ Chip must be purchased in stacks of 20. Each Player receives his own color of chips to ensure accurate bets and payoffs.
- ★ Chips can be purchased in denominations of \$0.50, \$1, \$5, \$25 and \$100.
- ★ Bets can be placed until the Dealer signals that the ball is ready to leave the track.
- ★ Winning bets are paid according to the amount of chips placed on the winning number and the odds associated with the bet.

How to Play

- ★ Play begins when all bets are placed. The diagram on back indicates the different types of Roulette bets.
- ★ When all bets are placed, the Dealer spins a small white ball in the opposite direction of the spinning Roulette wheel.
- ★ After the ball falls into a number on the Roulette wheel, the Dealer places a marker on the winning number and pays the winning bets.

Layout & Bets

FIVE NUMBER BETS

On this corner to cover the top five numbers (0, 00, 1, 2, and 3). Pays 6 to 1.

0 OR 00 BETS

Same as single number bets. Pays 35 to 1.

TWO NUMBER SPLIT BETS

Place your chips on the line between any two numbers. Either number pays 17 to 1.

SINGLE NUMBER BETS

This bet is made by placing your chips directly on a single numbered space. Any number 1 through 36, pays 35 to 1.

DOZEN OR SECTION BETS

Any numbers from 1 through 12; 13 through 24; or 25 through 36, pays 2 to 1.

EVEN MONEY BETS

Red or black; odd or even; 1 through 18; or 19 through 36, pays even money.

SIX NUMBER BETS

Any group of six numbers across pays 5 to 1.

THREE NUMBER BETS

Bet on the line to the left of any row of three numbers. Any of these numbers pays 11 to 1.

COLUMN BETS

You may bet on all the numbers in any column. All 12 numbers in any column pays 2 to 1.

FOUR NUMBER CORNER BETS

Place your bets at the intersection of any four numbers. Any of the four numbers pays 8 to 1.
